Burl Edward Hudson, 81 of Terre Haute, passed away 4:14 p.m. Saturday, November 3, 2007 at Terre Haute Regional Hospital.

Born June 19, 1926 in Owensburg, he was the son of Roy and Stella (Hatfield) Hudson.

He was a member of the Terre Haute community since 1965, he was a member of the Solsberry Masonic Lodge #411, the Scottish Rite and Zorah Shrine in Terre Haute, and retired as a rate analyst from Conrail in 1980 after 30 years of service.

Mr. Hudson was a member of the greatest generation, having served his country with distinction during World War II. A decorated soldier serving under General Patton, his sweep into Germany included assisting in the liberation of the Nordhausen concentration camp, along with being the second American tank to enter Berlin.

Mr. Hudson was a loving husband and father who will be greatly missed by all. He spent his retirement years enjoying time with his family, in addition to pursuing several hobbies.

Surviving relatives include: his wife, whom he married December 25, 1948, Betty Ann Hudson of Terre Haute; three sons, Tony Hudson of Terre Haute, Tim Hudson of Laramie, Wyoming, and Trent Hudson of Terre Haute; his sister, Anne Hirth of Owensburg; Grandson, Todd Hudson of Canton, Georgia; granddaughter, Traci Rusek and her husband Pavel of Woodstock, Georgia; and a great, granddaughter, Chloe Rusek of Woodstock, Georgia.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Tunis Hudson.
