Charles Eugene Farmer, 92, of Bloomfield, passed away peacefully early Tuesday, April 4, 2017, at the IU Health Hospice House in Bloomington, IN, with his daughter at his side. Charles was born June 27, 1924, to Gilbert and Paulina (Brandenburg) Farmer.

Charles was a graduate of Hardinsburg High School, and was among the last World World II Veterans in Greene County. He was an avid hunter and fisherman.
