Clarence O. Hamlin, 82, of Bloomfield, passed away 3:42 p.m. Friday February 29, 2008 at Veterans Hospital in Indianapolis.

Born June 14, 1925 in Greene County, he was the son of Chester D. and Ines (Hedge) Hamlin.

He was a receipt control expediter for NWSC crane retired. Later he drove a transportation car for the Veterans Affairs Officer. He was a member of the American Legion Post 196 in Bloomfield, was Bishop at the Pentecost Church of Zion in French Lick, and was a member of Pleasant Ridge Church. He served his country in World War II in the United States Navy.
