



Cora Belle (Pearson) Beck

November 7, 1918 - October 16, 2014

Our beloved Cora Belle Pearson Beck (b.November 7, 1918) passed away the evening of October 16, 2014 with the comfort of her family at Meadowood Health Pavilion, Bloomington Indiana.
