Dallas Ray Quillen "Buster," 86, of Bloomington, Indiana, died Tuesday at 7:05 in Bloomington. He was a patient at the IU Health Hospice House. He was born October 21, 1929, in Oolitic, Indiana, the son of George and Bertha Pearl Dove Quillen.

He was a Air Force Veteran and served during the Korean Conflict. While he was in the Air Force he visited many places.
