



Daniel M. Axe

May 13, 1923 - November 23, 2007

Daniel M. Axe, 84, of Bloomfield, passed away 1:55 p.m. Friday, November 23, 2007 at Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis.

Born May 13, 1923 in Detroit, Michigan, he was the son of Daniel and Nelle L. (Baker) Axe.

He was a self-employed accountant and a charter member of the Faith Christian Church in Bloomfield. He was a 50 year member of the Bloomfield Masonic Lodge #84, Terre Haute Scottish Rite, Phi Kappa Psi Fraternity, and the Bloomfield American Legion post # 196, and an Eagle Scout. He was a member of the Bloomfield Town Board from January 1, 1960 to December 31, 1967. He was Valedictorian of the Bloomfield Class of 1941. He was a graduate of Indiana University in 1948, earning a Bachelor of Science degree in business administration.

Daniel served his country in the U.S. Army in WWII and the Korean war. He was a member of the 42nd Rainbow division fighting in the battle of the Bulge where he was injured on January 21, 1945. He rose to rank of First Lieutenant during the Korean war.

Surviving relatives include: his wife, Enid C. (Hasler) Axe of Bloomfield; two sons, Carroll (C.B.) Bohley of Indianapolis and Roger D. Axe of Bloomfield; three grandchildren, Jamie Evans of Bloomfield, Tara Bohley of North Carolina, and Joshua Q. Axe of Bloomfield, and his great, grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents and sister, Margaret Wonder.

There will be no public visitation. Memorial services will be conducted 1:00

P.M. Saturday, December 1, 2007 at Faith Christian Church in Bloomfield, with Rev. Arlen Pope officiating. Masonic services will be performed at the church by the Bloomfield Masonic Lodge #84. Interment will be in Walnut Grove cemetery.
