David Joseph Leveque III 65, of Owensburg, passed away 2:31 p.m. Sunday, August 2, 2009 at Mitchell Manor.

Born February 29, 1944 in Linton, he was the son of David Joseph II and Mary Lou (Johnson) Leveque.

He was a Electronics technician for NSWC Crane retiring in 1994 after 30 years of service. He was the owner and operator of Dave's Satellite from 1984 - 1998. He served his country in the Vietnam era in the U.S. Navy. He was a member of the honor guard for President John F. Kennedy's Funeral ceremony.

Surviving relatives include: his wife, Nancy (Jackson) Leveque whom he married December 8, 1962; one daughter, Renee and her husband Danny Workman of Solsberry; one son, David J. Leveque IV and wife Kelly of Needmore; one brother, Gary D. Leveque of Springville; and his grandchildren, Elizabeth, Danielle, Josh, and Dalton.
