December 13, 1932 - June 15, 2020

Don Lewis Driscol 87, of McKinney, Texas, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Monday, June 15, 2020.

Born December 13, 1932 in Greene County, Indiana, he was the son of Lewis Raymond and Lillian Elmira (Redelman) Driscol.
