



Eldon Loren Stalcup

May 24, 1929 - March 22, 2016

Eldon Loren Stalcup, 86, lifelong resident of Bloomfield until 2014, passed away at 10:28 a.m. Tuesday, March 22, 2016 at his home in Pendleton, Indiana.

Born May 24, 1929 in Bloomfield, he was the son of Charles and Zelda (Blaker) Stalcup.

He worked as an electronic engineer for Sarkes Tarzian in Bloomington, Channel Four in Indianapolis, Hoosier Energy in Bloomington, and Indiana Higher Education Television Systems (IHETS) in Indianapolis. Following his retirement from IHETS, he loved working at the Bloomfield Carnegie Public Library, where he converted the library's bookkeeping system from ledgers to a computerized system. He especially loved all his co-workers at the library. Eldon was a member of Allen Chapel Church just outside Bloomfield.

He is survived by his wife, Elzenia (Fuller) Stalcup, lifelong resident of Bloomfield until 2014, currently residing in Pendleton; two daughters, Mindy Stalcup (David) Haag of Pendleton and Kathy (Stalcup) Marker of Clermont; a brother, Robert Stalcup of Fort Wayne; eight grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his son, Roger; brothers, Charles, Herbert, and

Wilmer; a grandson, Andrew; and his parents.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 26, 2016 at Jenkins Funeral Home in Bloomfield, with Pastor Paul McHenry officiating. Interment will follow in Fairview Cemetery in Linton.
