Enid C. Axe 91, of Indianapolis formerly of Bloomfield, passed away at 9:27 a.m. Wednesday, March 31, 2010 at the Westside Retirement Village in Indianapolis.

Born August 1, 1918 in Greene County, she was the daughter of Vactor and Mary (McGinnis) Hasler.

She was a telephone operator for Indiana Bell retiring in 1961 after 23 years of service. She was also a homemaker and a charter member of the Faith Christian Church in Bloomfield. She was a member of the Delta Theta Tau sorority and the Telephone Pioneers of America. She was also a 1936 graduate of Bloomfield High School.
