Floyd D. "Dick" Campbell, 87, of Solsberry, passed away at 10:40 p.m. on Friday, September 12, 2014 at IU Health Hospice House in Bloomington. Born May 23, 1927 in Greene County, he was the son of William and Maude (Carmichael) Campbell.

He retired from NSWC Crane in the transportation department and served his country in World War II in the United States Navy. He was a member of the Solsberry United Methodist church and the Solsberry American Legion. He enjoyed music and playing the guitar.

Surviving relatives include: his wife, Rowena Mae (Sherrow) Campbell whom he married August 23, 1947; one sister, Mary Ruth Hostettler of Bloomfield; and several nieces, nephews, brother-in-laws and sister-in-laws.
