



## James Edward Crabb

October 22, 1931 - May 4, 2007

James Edward Crabb, 75, of Bloomfield, passed away at 3:15 a.m. Friday May 4, 2007 at his residence.

Born October 22, 1931 in Corning, Arkansas, he was the son of James Alvin and Martha Melvina (Chandler) Crabb Duncan.
