Jean Resler 92, of Bloomfield, passed away on Wednesday, May 8, 2019 at Hearthstone in Bloomington.

Born July 4, 1926 in Bloomfield, she was the daughter of Fredrick Olaf and Verna (Hill) Wright.

Jean was a medical assistant for Dr. M.S.Mount in Bloomfield for 38 years. She was co-owner of Resler Block with her husband. She was a member of the First Baptist Church in Bloomfield, serving as treasurer as well as Sunday school teacher, also a Delta Theta Tau a Philanthropic sorority. She was a member of the "ERH" 1st Baptist cooks, the Order of Eastern Star and the Lady Elks. She was one of the original Monday morning coffee girls of Bloomfield.
