

## Jerry L. Hudson

September 22, 1941 - January 11, 2026

Jerry L. Hudson, 84, of Bloomfield, went to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, on Sunday, January 11, 2025, at Daviess Community Hospital.

He was born September 22, 1941, in Linton, Indiana, to Alvin D. and Marjorie J. (Crowe) Hudson.

Jerry was a high school graduate of Bloomfield High School and a graduate of Indiana University. He was a loyal fan of Indiana University and watched many, if not all, games I.U. played. He was a teacher for 40 plus years. He taught school at Eastern Greene Elementary and Oakland City before moving to Kingman, Arizona, and teaching at Kingman High School, before retiring from Kingman Academy of Learning in 2009. Jerry was an avid reader and loved to watch old westerns.

Jerry was married to Kathryn "Elaine" Hudson on August 27, 1966, in a joint ceremony with Elaine's twin sister, Loraine, and Jerry's cousin, Bill Hosteter.

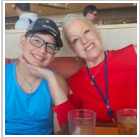
