Joseph B Strange of Bloomfield passed away Thursday February 25, at Owen Valley Health Care Campus in Spencer. Born March 30, 1922 in Washington, Indiana the son of John E. and Anna C. (Williams) Strange, he was a graduate of Washington High School Class of 1941. He enlisted in the Army Air Corps January 1942, where he served during World War II and Korea, retiring from the Air Force in August of 1964. He moved his family to Bloomfield and worked at NSWC Crane until retiring in February 1986. He was a member of Holy Name Catholic Church and a lifetime member of the V.F.W. in Middletown, Ky.
