Keith “Scooter” Biggs, age 75, of Lyons, passed away peacefully on Friday, December 30, 2022, at the Terre Haute Regional Hospital surrounded by his loved ones. He was born in Linton, IN on August 31, 1947, the son of Melvin & Jean (Bradfield) Biggs.
