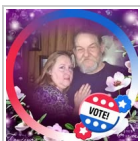

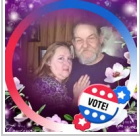

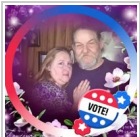


“ *Dear Karen and Chuck,*
