Larry Dean Hasler, 68, of Lyons, passed away at 11:41 a.m. Saturday, March 22, 2008 at Greene County General Hospital.

Born March 2, 1940 in Francesville, Indiana, he was the son of Frank and Fern (Cook) Hasler.

Larry earned a masters degree from Indiana State University. He was a retired school teacher. He was currently serving as Greene County Commissioner where he was on the Greene County drainage board, he was serving on the Greene County Hospital Board, was a member of the Elks lodge where he participated in the bowling and golf leagues. He was a former Junior high school and high school basketball, softball, and baseball coach. He was a basketball referee, member of the Sons of the American Legion in Lyons, and the Lyons United Methodist church.

Surviving relatives include: his wife Karon, whom he married November 25, 1964; two daughters, Timi Smith and her husband Jeff of Dugger and Tracy Hasler of Lyons; one brother, Dick Hasler and his wife Rita of Bloomfield; five grandchildren, Ashley, Trey, Sydney, William, and McKinley; stepmother, Pauline Hasler of Odon; and several Aunts and Uncles.
