Leland E. (Lee) Hutchens 60, of Bloomfield, passed away 6:00 p.m. Monday, March 1, 2010 at his residence.

Born May 31, 1949 in Bloomington, he was the son of Medus Eugene and Luvina (Williams) Hutchens.
