Leslie Carl Allen 87, of Bloomfield, passed away at 3:26 p.m. Sunday, January 17, 2010 at Union Hospital in Terre Haute.

Born July 10, 1922 in Koleen he was the son of Lon and Sarah Elizabeth (Haywood) Allen.

He retired from NSWC Crane in the ordnance department and served his country in the U.S. Army in WWII. He was a member of the Bloomfield First Christian Church, Bloomfield Masonic Lodge #84, Bloomfield Order of Eastern Star #538, Scottish Rite Indianapolis and the Bloomfield Odd Fellows Lodge.
