



## Luther William Haddock

February 8, 1927 - September 20, 2008

Luther William Haddock, 81, of Bloomfield, passed away 3:30 p.m. Saturday, September 20, 2008 at Bloomington Hospital.

Born February 8, 1927 in Memphis, Tennessee, he was the son of Isaac Jefferson and Katy (Sykes) Haddock. He married Hazel Geneva Williams on March 21, 1948 at Hopkinsville, Kentucky.

Luther owned, operated, and cooked at his own restaurant in Kentucky. He was an electromotive mechanic for NSWCC Crane and in Clarksville, Tennessee for years. He was a shoe cobbler and tent maker. He was a Jack of all trades: mechanic, carpenter, electrician, and plumber. Nothing he couldn't do. He lived with Nancy and kids for nearly 37 years. He loved to fish, boat, swim, hunt, and all things with all the children. He was never too busy to help them at any time.

Luther served his country in World War II with the United States Army. He served in the Aleutian Islands on Shemya Island in and around Alaska, SKA. He was a high Priest in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints in Linton. Luther helped Nancy over the Genealogy program for 10 years. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge #84 and Order of Eastern Star for over 25 years, the Greene County Genealogical Society and the Scotland Historical Society. He worked with the JC's for 4-5 years in the food tent and the Jr. Miss program. He was a member of the Bloomfield American Legion Post 196.
