



## Martha Elizabeth Martin

July 9, 1926 - October 21, 2013

On October 21, 2013, Martha Elizabeth (Brown) Martin passed away at St. Vincent's Indiana Heart Center in Carmel. Mrs. Martin was 87 years old. She was born in Evansville, Indiana on July 9, 1926, to Fred and Hazel (Johnson) Brown. She had one brother, Bill. In 1933 her family moved from Evansville to Newberry, a small farming community in Greene County, Indiana. She was a 1943 graduate of Newberry High School. Mr. and Mrs. Martin had five children: Christina, Patrick, Kit, Pete, and Polly; five grandchildren, Max, Adrienne, Allison, Emily and Curtis; and two great-grandchildren, Eric and Nathan.

Mrs. Martin was married 67 years to Harrel who preceded her in death on April 4, 2013.
