Maryann Pataconi-Rehner (84) of Bloomfield, Indiana died Thursday morning, January 22nd, 2015 at peace in her home surrounded by her loving family. Born Mary Ann LeRoy in Tulsa, Oklahoma on September 23rd, 1930 to parents Gustave A. and Alice Frances (Genaux) LeRoy, her parents moved home to White Cloud, Michigan at the height of the Dust Bowl in the 1930s to live out her father's dream to be a farmer. Maryann graduated from White Cloud High School in 1949, from Mercy Central School of Nursing in Grand Rapids, Michigan and several years later from Ball Memorial Anesthesia School in Muncie, Indiana. Maryann was a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA), practicing nursing for over 40 years in a variety of hospitals across the country, before retiring from Greene County General Hospital in 1995. Maryann is preceded in death by her parents and her brother Paul. She is survived by her husband, Bobby; children Michelle Bensman and Jean Voster of Breed, Wisconsin; Ed and Marie Bensman of South Bend, Indiana; and her grand-daughters Julia and Maclaine.
