Max Robert Floyd, 89, of Bloomfield, passed away at 9:30 p.m. on Monday, June 11, 2012 at Ketcham Memorial Nursing Home in Odon.

Born October 27, 1922 in Greene County, he was the son of Joseph Elmer and Effie Mae (Denman) Floyd.
