



## Rev. Max S. Skinner

February 11, 1922 - October 3, 2012

Rev. Max S. Skinner, 90, of Bloomfield, passed away at 5:24 p.m.

Wednesday, October 3, 2012 at Lyons Health and Living Center.

Born February 11, 1922 in Greene County, he was the son of Harvey and Caroline (Hash) Skinner.

He was a minister for 54 years at Sharkey Church and a butcher for the Bloomfield Locker Plant. He served in World War II in the United States Navy. Surviving relatives include: his wife, Marjorie (Bland) Skinner of Bloomfield; three sons, Ron Skinner, Bobby Don Skinner and David Mark Skinner all of Bloomfield; three brothers, Vernon Skinner of Marion, Miles Skinner of Bloomfield and Marion Skinner of Boston, Massachusetts; five grandchildren and twelve great grandchildren.
