The family asks that all memorial contributions be made to Andrew Curtis to assist with Funeral Costs.

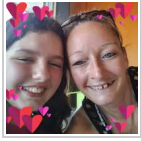

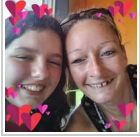
