June 23, 1922 - June 25, 2021

Paul Eugene Helms, 99, of Bloomfield, passed away on Friday, June 25, 2021 at the Brown County Health and Living Community in Nashville, IN.

Born June 23, 1922 in Greene County, he was the son of McKinley and Helen (Barge) Helms.

He was a veteran of WWII serving with the 94th Infantry Division in Europe. He received a Purple Heart and Bronze Star for his service. He worked as a heavy truck driver at Crane. After retiring from Crane, he continued operating his bulldozer business until he was in his early 80's. He was a farmer and member of the Pleasant Ridge Church. He lived at his home in Bloomfield until his death.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his sisters Pauline Holtsclaw, Laura Jane Hamlin, Esther Cox, and brother George; a grandson, Samuel Earl Helms, one great-great grandchild and his wife of 70 years, Dorrotha Jean (Fuller) Helms.

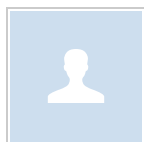
