



Robert Cain "Bob" Yoho

August 27, 1923 - January 25, 2012

Robert Cain "Bob" Yoho, 88, of Bloomfield, passed away 2:14 a.m. Wednesday, January 25, 2012 at St. Vincent's Hospital in Indianapolis. Born August 27, 1923 in Solsberry, he was the son of Wayne and Gertie (Sherrow) Yoho.

Bob was a supervisor in ordinance at NSWC Crane, retiring in 1985 after 32 years of service. He was a member of Faith Christian Church, Past President of the Bloomfield Town Board, Past Master of the Solsberry Masonic Lodge, Charter member of the Solsberry American Legion, Charter member of the Terre Haute Scottish Rite, Past President of the Bloomfield Little League and the Bloomfield Lyons Club. He served his country with the United States Army in World War II.

Surviving relatives include: one son, Robert Scott Yoho (Shelli) of Bloomfield; daughter-in-law, Nellie R. Yoho (David R.
