Robert Barry Feutz, 56, passed away peacefully surrounded by loved ones Friday, March 17, 2017 at IU Health Bloomington Hospital.

He was born July 5, 1960 in Linton, Indiana to Robert R. and Doris June (Hayse) Feutz.

Rob grew up in Doans, Indiana and was a 1979 graduate of Bloomfield High School. Rob was an extremely talented musician as well as a singer and songwriter. Rob was very passionate about his music and never gave up on his dreams. Playing Banjo and guitar at a very young age, he won the Tri-State Banjo competition at the age of 11. In his early years he played in Tanya Tucker's band and toured internationally with Suzy Bogguss. He also co-wrote a top 100 hit for Mason Dixon, "Don't Say No Tonight" in the 80's. He is a two time Indiana State Banjo Champion and his most recent award is the 2014 WBDC's 33rd Annual Country Showdown Champion. On top of his numerous awards, he and his own band played alongside Charlie Daniels. Rob and his band were also the opening act for bands such as Molly Hatchet, .38 Special, Aaron Tippin, The Marshall Tucker Band and Lynyrd Skynyrd.

Rob was a loving father to Kristen Feutz of Avon and Lacy Hart of Washington. He is also survived by his parents, Rob and June Feutz of Doans, his brother, Vance Feutz of Bloomington, one sister, Missy Perkins of

Doans, his grandchildren, Hunter and Hadley. He is also survived by four nieces, one nephew and several aunts, uncles and cousins.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11:00 a.m. Thursday, March 23, 2017 at Jenkins Funeral Home in Bloomfield, with Rev. Ron Helderman officiating. Interment will follow in Owensburg Cemetery.

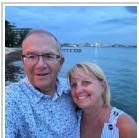
