Robert L. Heaton, 84, of Bloomfield, passed away at 4:45 a.m. Tuesday, September 11, 2012 at Keepsake Village in Columbus.

Born March 24, 1928 in Bloomfield, he was the son of Floyd and Mabel (Johnson) Heaton.

He retired from NSWC Crane as a Tech writer and editor for the Naval Department. He served his country in the Korean War with the United States Army.
