Roger B. Doane, 81, of Bloomfield passed away Monday October 12, 2020 at Union Hospital in Terre Haute.

Born September 28, 1939 in Jasper, Indiana the son of Bert C. and Lillian (Fehribach) Doane.

Roger was a U.S. Navy veteran, he was a retired Computer Specialist from Crane, had worked for IBM and Bloomfield School, he was a member of the Holy Name of Jesus Catholic Church in Bloomfield, founding member of the Knight's of Columbus in Linton, Bloomfield Jaycee's, Bloomfield Lions Club, served on the Board of Directors at St. Meinrad, Board of Trustees for the Bloomfield Eastern Greene Public Library, served as Chairman of the Bloomfield Town Council and was a member of the Emergency Planning Committee.
