



Shirley Roscoe Jewell

March 11, 1934 - January 22, 2011

Shirley Roscoe Jewell, 76, of Lyons, passed away at 2:45 a.m. Saturday, January 22, 2011 at his residence.

Born March 11, 1934 in Louisville, Kentucky, he was the son of Samuel and Rosa (Greenwell) Jewell.

He was an electronic technician for Brown's TV in Lyons and later owned and operated S & D Sales in Lyons. He was a Deputy Sheriff in Monroe County. He served his country in the Korean war with the United States Air Force and in later years served in the U.S. Army. He was a member of the Calvary Baptist Church in Linton, American Legion post #479 in Lyons, and AMVETS post # 2000 in Bloomington.

Surviving relatives include: his wife, Dora Mae (Niceley) Jewell whom he married June 12, 1953; his children, Terry R. Jewell (Mary) of Bloomington, Vicki S.
