Stanley Richard (Dick) Vaughn 75, of Bloomfield, passed away at 12:58 p.m. Saturday, September 11, 2010 at Bloomington Hospital.

Born August 28, 1935 in Indianapolis to Norman and Evelyn (Smith) Vaughn. He worked for the Monon Railroad through five mergers and retired from CSX in 1997 after 44 years of service. He joined the first National Guard unit in Linton on May 4, 1953 and served 8 years. He was a member of the Worthington Masonic Lodge #577 and the Zorah Shrine in Indianapolis. He married Joan Neihart Myers on January 1, 1955 and she survives. They have three children; Mike Vaughn of Pennsylvania, Rick Vaughn of Bloomfield and Kellee Webb (John) also of Bloomfield; five grandchildren, Dustin Vaughn, Nicole Vaughn, Skyler Pittman, Ryan Pittman and Amanda Vaughn; one Aunt, Nada Young of Dugger also survives.
