Velma Oaklene McIntosh, 85, of Bloomfield passed away Saturday January 31, 2015 at Greene County General Hospital in Linton.

Born February 23, 1929 in Greene County, Indiana the daughter of Elmer Earl and Cleo Bea (Bough) Cooper.

Oaklene served two terms as Greene County Treasurer, she had worked at the Greene County Sherriff's department, served as the Richland Township Trustee for several years and was a homemaker. She was a member of the Tulip Church of God, Vice Chairman for the Republican Party and President for the Republican Women's group, she received the highest distinction in Indiana, The Sagamore of the Wabash award.

Surviving relatives include her children, Monte (Sue) McIntosh, Tom (Laura) McIntosh, Bob (Mandy) McIntosh, Karen (Mike) Burnett and Kenny (Kathy) McIntosh all of Bloomfield, sixteen grandchildren and thirty great grandchildren.
