Walter Byers 94, of Bloomfield, passed away at 12:36 a.m. Wednesday, October 26, 2011 at his residence.

Born September 30, 1917 in Bloomfield, he was the son of William Martin and Della (Graham) Byers.

He retired in 1984 from NSWC Crane as a maintenance machinist after 41 years of service. He served his country with the U.S. Army in WW II. He was a member of the Mineral United Methodist Church.
