Wilbur Dale "Buster" Sipes, 85, of Plainfield formerly of Newberry, passed away at 10:15 a.m. Thursday, May 16, 2013 at Plainfield Health Care and Rehab.

Born January 18, 1928 in Daviess County, he was the son of Jess and Rebecca (Cox) Sipes.

He was a mail carrier for the United State Postal Service serving the areas of Jasonville, Newberry and Switz City. He retired in 1995 after 33 years of service.
