Wilford D. Sircy, 84, of Elnora, passed away 10:30 a.m. Sunday, September 7, 2008 at Greene County General Hospital.

Born February 27, 1924 in Jackson County, Tennessee, he was the son of Ellis and Florence (Dixon) Sircy.
