William R. (Bill) Isenogle, 85, of Bloomfield passed away Sunday March 7, 2010 at the Bloomington Hospital. He was born March 13, 1924 in Marion County to William Cyrus and Rebecca (Lester) Isenogle. Bill served his country in WWII with the US Army. After the war he attended Wabash College prior to graduating from Indiana University with in education. After teaching at Pennville and Ben Davis in Indianapolis, he came to Greene County where he taught school before joining the faculty at Bloomfield High School. Bill Left teaching to take a job with the federal government at what is now NSWC, retiring in 1988.
