William Joseph "Joe" Haldeman, 88, of Bloomfield passed away at 11:10 P.M. on Wednesday May 9, 2007 at Glenburn Home in Linton.

Born August 29, 1918 in Bloomfield he was the son of James & Lelia (Bingham) Haldeman.

He was a salesman for John E. Smith Company out of Indianapolis. He was an Army veteran of WWII. He was an Airplane Maintenance Technician. He received the Bronze Star. He was a member of the Bloomfield American Legion Post # 196, and was a former town board member for Bloomfield. He held the Indiana State scoring record for football at Bloomfield High School, in 1937 he scored 165 points in nine games averaging three touchdowns per game. He was known as "Jolting" Joe Haldeman.

Surviving relatives include his wife Louellen (Floyd) Haldeman of Bloomfield. 1 son Jim Haldeman of Bloomfield. 1 daughter Linda Schaeffer of New Albany, Indiana. 4 grandchildren & 5 great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, 1 brother & 1 sister.
